Dear Scouts on stamps collector;

Here is the check list you ordered. A line thru the appropriate box indicates that an issue was made for that category.

I use this list by placing an (M) mint or (U) used in red under the cross line to show each issue I own. Above the line I'll place a (2) for a pair, (PB) for a plate block, (4) for a block, (S) for a full sheet, etc.

The stamps listed for Oman are for reference only as they are not listed in Scotts or Minkus or recognized by the U.P.U..

All catalog numbers are from the Scott catalog except when preceded by an (M) for Minkus.

As you use this list I would like to know of any corrections or additions you may come across. This list was checked by several outstanding collectors of and dealers in Scout stamps. I would particularly like to thank Mr. Howard Kaplan for all of his help.


Some of the dates of issue may differ from what you now show but we believe ours to be correct.

The categories across the top of the check list are as follows:

- PERF.-- Perforated stamp
- IMPERF. Imperforated stamp
- MINI SHEET -- Sheet with plain or decorated borders and no more than 20 stamps
- S/S PERF.-- Perforated stamps on souvenir sheet or stamps with simulated perforations
- S/S IMPERF.-- Imperforate stamps on souvenir sheet (P) paper (C) cardboard
- DELUXE S/S-- Varies with issue. Those of the French Stamp Printing Office usually on cardboard with stamp in color of issue. Sometimes matted.
- S-SPEC. M-MIHON--Regular perforate stamp or souvenir sheet with "SPECIMEN" across face or bar thru value. Mihn in characters across face of stamp.
- GUTTER PAIRS-- At least two stamps with selvage between
- PROOF -- Imperforate stamp in color other than that of issue
- PROOF STRIP (5)-- Imperforate strip of 5 stamps issued by the French Stamp Printing Office, 4 in various solid colors, 1 multicolored.
  
- ARTIST'S PROOF-- Light cardboard with stamp in single color-not issue color-with the seal of the French Stamp Printing Office and the designers signature
- MISC.-- Used at your discretion for errors, freaks, etc.

It is my hope that this list will add to your enjoyment of and assist you in your collecting of Scout stamps.
