The design of this imprinted stamp is by Stevan Dohanos and is based on the Jamboree Patch which shows the Fleur-de-lis emblem of Scouting and Borah Peak, highest point in Idaho. Scouts from nearly one hundred nations and territories attended the encampment August 1-9, the first ever staged in the United States. The theme of the Jamboree was "For Friendship." The twelfth Jamboree re-created the first encampment staged by Sir Robert Baden-Powell sixty years before.



6-Cent BOY SCOUT WORLD JAMBOREE AIR MAIL POSTAL CARD



The 6-cent air mail postal card saluting the Boy Scouts' XII World Jamboree will be first placed on sale on August 4, 1967, at Farragut State Park, Idaho, where Scouts from nearly one hundred nations and territories will be encamped.

This air mail card is valid for postage to Canada and Mexico, in addition to all points in the United States and its possessions. It may be used to send messages to other countries by affixing adhesive stamps to meet the required rate.

Stevan Dohanos, a member of the Citizens' Stamp Advisory Committee, designed the stamp on the card. It is based on the Jamboree patch which shows the fleur-de-lis emblem of Scouting and Borah Peak, the highest point in Idaho, the host State to the Scouts.

Ten million cards will be printed by the Government Printing Office in two runs on a two-color offset, press blending yellow, blue, red and black inks. Maximum blending occurs in the fleur-de-lis in which the bronze color is achieved by interspersing half-tone dots in the four inks.

Collectors desiring first day cancellations should send their orders to the Postmaster, Coeur d'Alene, Idaho 83814, plainly indicating the full name and address, INCLUDING ZIP CODE, with remittance to cover the cost, which is six cents each. The first day covers will be postmarked with a special cancellation reading "FARRAGUT STATE PARK, ID, AUGUST 4, 1967." The envelope to the Postmaster should be plainly endorsed "First Day Covers 6¢ Boy Scout Jamboree Card."
