Stamp album page with handwritten explanation of the Mafeking siege postal operations by then-Lieutenant General Baden-Powell (early 1900s). (1945 confirmation on reverse by Lady Baden-Powell that the handwriting is genuine.) These were Baden-Powell's most specific comments on the origin of the Baden-Powell head stamps. In 1980, the Mafeking diary of journalist/photographer Edward Ross was published. Ross took a photograph of Baden-Powell which was intended to have been the basis of the Baden-Powell head stamps - a photograph, Ross wrote, which Baden-Powell explained was needed for a stamp which was to be issued bearing his portrait. The "Mafeking Besieged" overprinted stamp, the two "blueprint" stamps, and the original typewritten text were placed on this page by the collector who created it.

During the Siege we used to send out letters by native runners, at night, through the Boer lines. These men we paid £15 a time. Many of them were shot by the enemy. To defray the cost letters were stamped at 1/6 each with Government Stamps surcharged.



Within the defences of Mafeking we had a postal system to enable people to communicate with friends at other parts of the defences. So the blue print stamps were issued for payment of the cyclist post boys. These ran considerable risks when going their rounds under fire. The stamp bearing my head was issued by Lord E. Cecil, my Staff Officer, as a surprise for me. It was my adversary commented on at home on the supposition that I had issued it myself!

The second series was for use on local messages conveyed between different points within the defences. It was produced by a photographic process upon ferro-prussiate paper by Dr. D. Taylor. The 1d. value, designed by Dr. W.A. Hayes, showed Serg-Major Goodyear of the Cyclist Cadet Corps, which was entrusted with the conveyance of the local post, whilst on the 3d. value appeared a portrait bust of Colonel (now Lieut-General) Sir R.S.S. Baden-Powell, the defender of Mafeking. At the close of hostilities these stamps were demonitised by order of the Cape Government, but to collectors they remain as historic souvenirs of a memorable siege.

## Robert Baden-Powell

Robert Stephenson Smyth Baden-Powell was born on February 22, 1857, in London, England. As an army officer, Baden-Powell specialized in scouting, map-making and reconnaissance. He was stationed in India and South Africa, among other places. In 1910, Baden-Powell retired from the military with the rank of Lieutenant-General. To test his ideas for youth scouting, Baden-Powell took a group of 22 boys camping on Brownsea Island in 1907, and the following year, published *Scouting for Boys*, which offered both practical information and philosophical writings on scoutcraft. A prolific artist and writer, Baden-Powell earned many honorary degrees, foreign orders and decorations, and many Scouting awards, including Chief Scout of the World. He died on January 8, 1941, and is buried in Nyeri, Kenya.

Robert Stephenson Smyth Baden-Powell est né le 22 février 1857 à Londres, en Angleterre. Cet officier de cavalerie fut basé en Inde et en Afrique du Sud, entre autres, où il se spécialisa dans les missions d'éclairage, de cartographie et de reconnaissance; il termina sa carrière militaire en 1910 comme lieutenant-général. En 1907, pour vérifier la manière dont les principes d'éclairage pourraient être adaptés à la jeunesse, Baden-Powell invita un groupe de 22 garçons à camper sur l'île Brownsea. L'année suivante, il publia l'ouvrage *Scouting for Boys*, traduit en français un peu plus tard sous le titre *Éclaireurs*, dans lequel il fixa les principes moraux de cet art tout en offrant une foule de conseils aux instructeurs. Artiste et auteur prolifique, Baden-Powell a obtenu de nombreux diplômes honorifiques, décorations, ordres étrangers et distinctions dans le domaine du scoutisme, dont le titre de chef scout du monde. Baden-Powell est décédé le 8 janvier 1941 à Nyeri, au Kenya, où il repose depuis.

Robert Baden-Powell

Robert Baden-Powell Smith Baden Powell was born on February 22, 1857, in London, England. As an army officer, Baden Powell specialised in scouting, map-making and reconnaissance. He was stationed in India and South Africa, among other places. In 1910, Baden Powell, retired from the military with the rank of Lieutenant General, founded the idea for youth scouting. Baden Powell took a group of 22 boys camping on Brownsea Island in 1907, and the following year published *Scouting for Boys*, which offered both practical information and philosophical writings on scouting. A prolific author and writer, Baden Powell wrote many literary classics, travel guides and story books, and many Scouting awards, including Chief Scout of the World. He died on January 8, 1941, and is buried in Funchal, Madeira.

## BROWNSEA ISLAND – HOME OF SCOUTING

Nearing retirement from the Army in 1906, Lieut. General Robert Baden-Powell wanted to put into practice some ideas that had been formulated during the Boer War. At the seige of Mafeking in 1899 boys had been used for a variety of tasks and "B-P" felt that "scouting" was something that would be welcomed and would probably fit into the Boys Brigade system of training. Accordingly, through Charles Van Raalte – the owner of Brownsea Island at the time – "B-P" arranged a camp to be held at the beginning of August 1907.

Half of the twenty boys invited to this camp were from Public Schools and of the remainder, seven were members of the Bournemouth Boys Brigade and three were from the Poole B.B. A full programme of training was undertaken and the results of this experimental camp exceeded B-P's expectations. Although a number of "scouting patrols" were formed in Boys Brigade units, the popularity of this new scheme was increased after the publication of "Scouting for Boys" and the Boy Scouts naturally evolved, through the exuberance and keenness of the young people, into a separate organisation.

"B-P" always likened Brownsea Island to the "little acorn" from which a "great oak" was grown and the Island today offers camping facilities in a natural environment to Scouts and Guides from all over the world.

There are three surviving members of the original camp in Brian Evans-Lombe (Public Schools), Terry Bonfield (Bournemouth) and Arthur Primmer (Poole) and the local "boys" are still visitors to the Island. The original camp site is one of eight that is controlled by the Brownsea Island Management Committee – a self-financing joint Guide and Scout organisation.

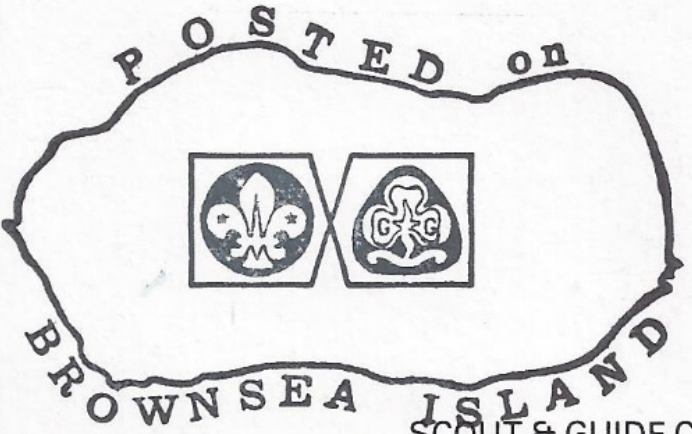




COMMEMORATIVE POSTCARD
